Mines

Throughout the southern part of Cornwall there are many derelict buildings of tin and copper mines. The miners fought a constant battle against water and the tall engine houses were built to house giant pumps which worked non-stop to drain the mines beneath. At its peak 300 mines were active. The mining levels in Cornish tin mines were calculated in **fathoms** and the man in charge of a shaft was given the title of **Captain**
